## Dredging in Belgium

- Maritime access: navigation channels to seaports
  - North sea: Belgian federal waters
    - Follow OSPAR, LC
  - Westerschelde: the Netherlands
    - Follow Dutch legislation
  - Sea scheldt: Flanders
- Inland shipping routes
  - Navigable channels: Flanders
  - Non-navigable channels: Flanders



## Common practice

- Relocation within the Scheldt estuary
  - Environmental license is required
  - DM is not considered hazardous
    - Intensive monitoring program to follow up
- Beneficial re-use is possible: Waste Decree
  - Application as soil or as construction material
  - Use certificate is needed
- Code of good practice: dredged material
  - Useful for dredging in non-navigable waters
  - Relation with Soil Decree
